Reporting to the Assistant Manager of Utilities, this position will be responsible for all maintenance and installation of the City's water and sewer infrastructure. This includes but is not limited to:

- Sanitary, storm and water maintenance and repair such as flushing mains, hydrant repair, valves, sewer blockages
- Performs regulatory maintenance on city water distribution & wastewater collection systems'
- Operates light equipment and may be required to assist with snowplowing, sanding and snow removal during winter months.

The successful candidate will hold an EOCP Class 1 Wastewater Collection and Class 1 Water Distribution Certificate. Sound knowledge of methods and procedures for the installation, repair and maintenance of sewer and water systems. BC, Class 3 with air brakes endorsement would be considered an asset.
