BY-LAW NO. 346, 1973 (66-346-K)

A By-law to close a portion of the road and lane shown on Plan 6596 covering part of Lot 2195, Kootenay District.

WHEREAS the owners of the adjoining properties have requested that the road on Plan 5596 be moved to adjoin the lane shown on the said plan, and

WHEREAS the said owners have submitted a plan covering such a change, and

WHEREAS the said owners have agreed to pay all costs involved in this change.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Kinnaird, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:-

1. Those portions of the road and lane shown outlined on the attached plan and originally created by Plan 6596 are hereby closed and stoppage of traffic of all kinds.
2. This by-law shall be advertised in the Canadian Government Gazette.
3. This by-law shall take effect upon registration in the office of the Inspector of Municipalities.

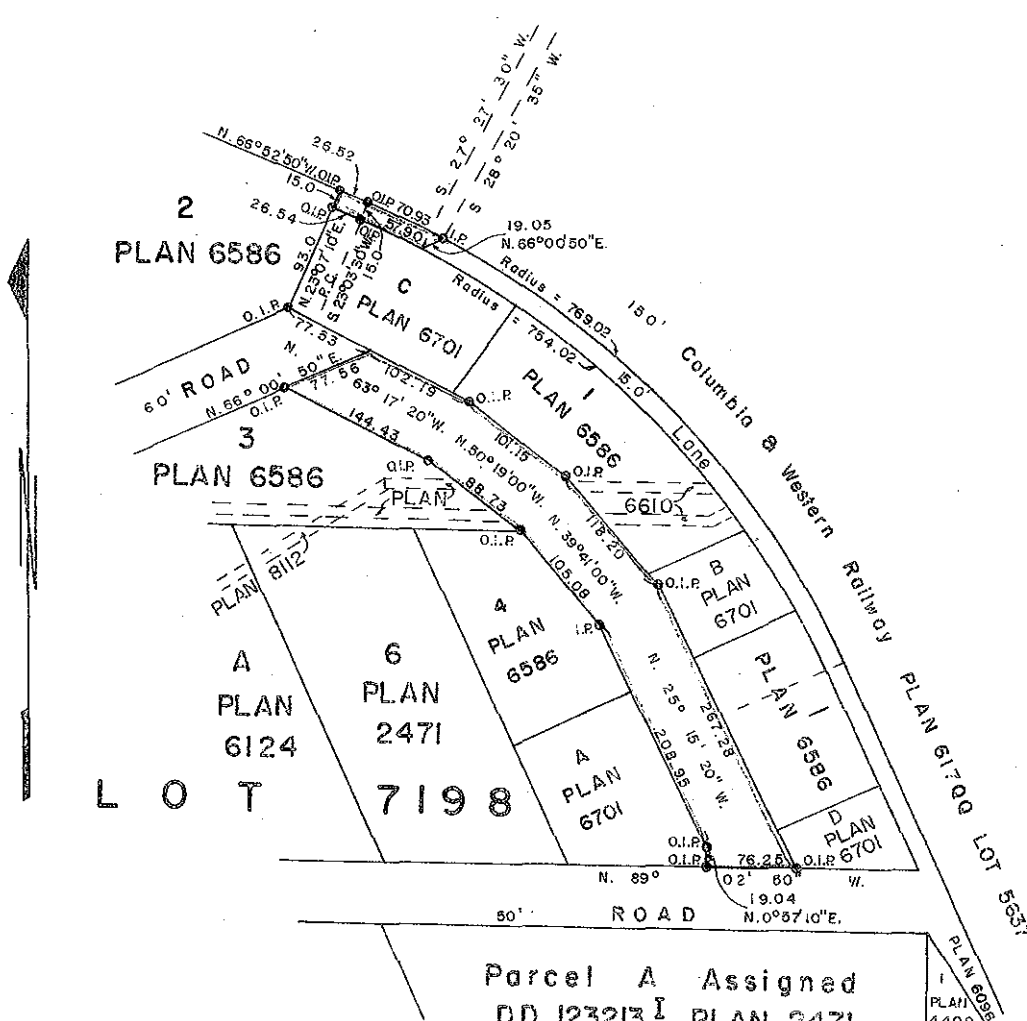

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 11 JUN 1974

Pursuant to the Municipal Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Kinnaird has by By-law No. 346, 1973 being a by-law to close a portion of road and lane shown on Plan 6586 covering part of Lot 7198, Kootenay District, a copy of which is hereto attached, stopped up and closed to traffic those portions of road and lane as shown outlined in red colour on the plan attached to and made part of said By-law No. 346:

AND WHEREAS the Council has requested the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the aforesaid portions of road and lane pursuant to section 508 and to vest title to the land comprising same in the name of the municipality and has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Minister of Municipal Affairs that special circumstances exist which warrant the making of this Order:

AND WHEREAS the consent of owners of contiguous properties has been obtained and the question of access is not in issue:

AND WHEREAS by Letters Patent issued the 13th day of December, 1973, the Town of Kinnaird and the Town of Castlegar were dissolved and the Letters Patent thereof revoked and the residents thereof incorporated as a City municipality known by the name of the City of Castlegar Kinnaird effective from 1st day of January, 1974:

AND WHEREAS by section 17 of the aforesaid Letters Patent all by-laws of the Town of Kinnaird shall remain in full force and effect as a by-law of the City of Castlegar Kinnaird:

AND WHEREAS by supplementary Letters Patent issued the 21st day of March, 1974, the name of the municipality was changed to the City of Castlegar:

THE REQUEST BE GRANTED and that the portions of road and lane aforesaid be abandoned and title to the lands comprising same be vested in fee simple in the name of the City of Castlegar without further instrument of transfer subject nevertheless to the reservations, limitations, provisos and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown and subject to the provisions of section 47 of the Land Act, and subject to consolidation with contiguous properties.

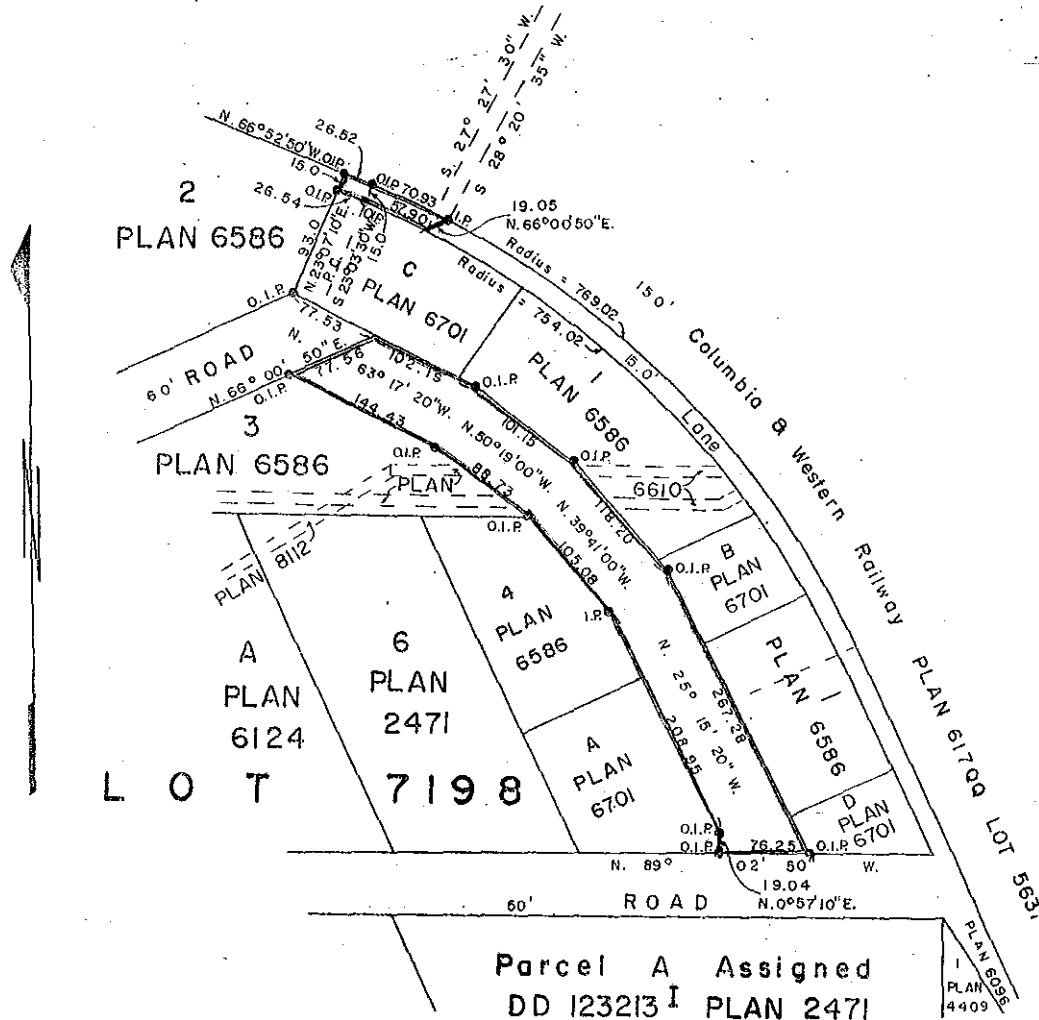
LOT 7198, KOOTENAI DISTRICT.
