

CITY OF CASTLEGAR

BYLAW 415

A bylaw respecting the Central Kootenay Union Board of Health and representation thereon from the Council of the City of Castlegar.

WHEREAS Section 48 of the Health Act (1979) provides that a municipality may, by bylaw, join with one or more other municipalities in establishing a union board of health, and provide for Council representation on such board;

AND WHEREAS it is proposed that a Central Kootenay Union Board of Health be formed as of July 1, 1984, comprising the present members of the West Kootenay Union Board of Health and the Selkirk Union Board of Health;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Castlegar is presently represented on the West Kootenay Union Board of Health;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal council of the City of Castlegar, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:


1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Union Board of Health Bylaw 415, 1984."
2. The City of Castlegar recognizes the establishment of the Central Kootenay Union Board of Health effective July 1, 1984, and shall be represented on the said Board by one member of Council.
3. Council shall annually, and as otherwise required, by resolution appoint the representative to the Central Kootenay Union Board of Health.
4. This bylaw shall be deemed effective upon final adoption.

READ A THIRD TIME this 12th day of June, 1984.
