

CITY OF CASTLEGAR

BYLAW 451

A bylaw to adopt a logo for the City of Castlegar.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Castlegar considers it desirable and in the public interest to adopt a corporate logo for use by the City on forms, stationery, advertising and other material printed or published by the City, for identifying the property of the City, and for such other uses as Council may from time to time determine;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Castlegar, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. There is hereby adopted a corporate logo for the City of Castlegar which shall include the words "City of Castlegar" and "Crossroads of the Kootenays", and the design of the logo shall be as shown hereunder.



2. No person shall, without the authority of Council, assume or use the corporate logo of the municipality or any emblem or symbol so nearly resembling it as to be calculated to deceive.
3. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon final adoption.
