

CITY OF CASTLEGAR

BYLAW 481

A bylaw to designate the Castlegar Station Building as a municipal heritage site.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest to declare the Castlegar Station Building a municipal heritage site;

AND WHEREAS Section 11 of Part 3 of the Heritage Conservation Act provides that Council may, by bylaw, designate a building, structure or land, in whole or in part, as a municipal heritage site;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Castlegar, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:


1. This bylaw may be cited as "Municipal Heritage Site Designation Bylaw".
2. The Castlegar Station Building located on that part of District Lot 4598 shown coloured pink on Plan 1484 except parts included in Plan 14201 and 14202, Kootenay District is hereby designated a municipal heritage site pursuant to the provisions of Part 3 of the Heritage Conservation Act.
3. Notice of intention to consider this bylaw shall be given in accordance with the provisions of Section 11 of Part 3 of the Heritage Conservation Act.
4. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon final adoption.


