BYLAW 1007

A bylaw to repeal the Local Improvement Fund Establishment Bylaw No. 732

WHEREAS in 1995 the Local Improvement Reserve Fund was established pursuant to section 381 (now repealed) of the Municipal Act, and;

WHEREAS all of the funds transferred to the Local Improvement Reserve Fund were transferred from general revenues of the City, and;

WHEREAS section 189 (2) and (4) of the Community Charter authorizes the transfer of funds from one reserve fund to another reserve fund, and;

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest to repeal the Local Improvement Fund Establishment Bylaw No. 732;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Castlegar, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Citation

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Local Improvement Fund Repealing Bylaw No. 1007.

Revisions


2. The Local Improvement Fund Establishment Bylaw No. 732 is hereby repealed.
3. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect when adopted.
