The purpose of a Public Hearing is to allow the public to make representations to the local government respecting matters contained in the proposed bylaw. Persons who believe that their interest in property is affected by the proposed bylaw shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions respecting matters contained in the bylaw that is the subject of the hearing.

[The Bylaws must proceed to the Public Hearing after first and before third reading. Following the Public Hearing Council considers third reading and adoption of the Bylaws. All readings of the bylaws take place at regular or special Council meetings which are open to the public.]

NOTE: Any person who wishes to have his/her opinion officially recorded in the minutes of the Public Hearing should follow the procedure as outlined below:

- the Chairman asks if anyone present has any questions or concerns;
- those wanting to speak raise their hands;
- when recognized by the Chairman, the individual stands and gives his/her name prior to making a presentation or asking questions; and
- all discussion, questions, etc., at the Public Hearing are addressed to the Chairman.
