# Municipal Ticketing Bylaw 1179

A bylaw to implement the Municipal Ticketing Information (M.T.I.) System

WHEREAS the Community Charter empowers the City, by bylaw, to designate those bylaws for which Municipal Ticket Information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement;

AND WHEREAS the Community Charter empowers the Council, by bylaw, to authorize the use of any word or expression on a Municipal Ticket Information to designate an offence against a bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to authorize the use of Municipal Ticket Information for the enforcement of certain bylaws, to authorize the use of certain words or expressions to designate certain bylaw offences, and to set certain fine amounts;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Castlegar, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

## TITLE

1. This bylaw may be cited as "Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw Number 1179, 2013".

## BYLAW CONTRAVENTIONS

2. The bylaws and bylaw contraventions designated in Schedule "B" to this bylaw, as amended from time to time, may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose pursuant to Chapter 26, Part 8, Division 3, of the Community Charter.

## BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

3. The persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule "A" to this bylaw are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers pursuant to Chapter 26, Part 8, Division 3, Section 264, 1(b) of the Community Charter for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule "A" opposite the respective job positions.

## OFFENCE AND PENALTY

4.
  - a. The words or expressions set forth in Column 2 of Schedule "B1" through "B17" of this Bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 1 of Schedule "B1" through "B17" opposite the respective words or expressions.

- b. Subject to subsection (c), the dollar amounts in Column 3 of Schedule "B1" through "B17" of this Bylaw are the fines for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1 of Schedule "B1" through "B17".
- c. If the fine is paid on or before the 30th day from the date on which the ticket is served, the dollars amounts in Column 4 of Schedule "B1" through "B17" of this Bylaw, if applicable, are the fines for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1 of Schedule "B1" through "B17". (Bylaw 1280)

**REPEAL**

- 5. The City of Castlegar Bylaw Number 731 cited as "Municipal Ticketing Bylaw No. 731, 1995" and all amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.
