# Water Restrictions

**JUNE 15 TO SEPTEMBER 15**

## Lawn/garden watering and car washing is restricted to every 2nd day



Residents at odd number addresses water on odd number calendar days

**ENDING IN 1, 3, 5, 7 OR 9**



Residents at even number addresses water on even number calendar days

**ENDING IN 0, 2, 4, 6 OR 8**



**Morning**  
5 a.m. to 11 a.m.



**Evening**  
5 p.m. to 11 p.m.

## Timed sprinkler systems can be set to run overnight on the every 2nd day schedule



**Overnight**  
11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

## \$50 fine levied for non-compliance

Under the City's Municipal Ticketing Bylaw 1179, a \$50 fine can be issued for prohibited sprinkling/irrigation.

## Why are there water restrictions?

Summer presents special water system problems

Excessive water use during the summer months can impact the City's main water supply.

### DID YOU KNOW?



Daily summer residential water use increases up to **200%**

This is due primarily to lawn and garden watering and car washing.

## Water Exemption Permits

Under special circumstances, residents can apply for a Water Use Exemption Permit.
