

Lawn/garden watering and car washing is restricted to every 2nd day



Residents at odd number addresses water on odd number calendar days

ENDING IN 1, 3, 5, 7 OR 9



Residents at even number addresses water on even number calendar days

ENDING IN 0, 2, 4, 6 OR 8



Morning 5 a.m. to 11 a.m.



Evening 5 p.m. to 11 p.m.

Timed sprinkler systems can be set to run overnight on the every 2nd day schedule



Overnight 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

\$50 fine levied for non-compliance

Under the City's Municipal Ticketing Bylaw 1179, a \$50 fine can be issued for prohibited sprinkling/irrigation.

Why are there water restrictions?

Summer presents special water system problems

Excessive water use during the summer months can impact the City's main water supply.

DID YOU KNOW?



Daily summer residential water use increases up to 200%

This is due primarily to lawn and garden watering and car washing.

Water Exemption Permits

Under special circumstances, residents can apply for a Water Use Exemption Permit.
