Currently seeking suitable candidates for two (2) Operations Worker positions, responsible for performing light equipment and labour work in a safe and competent manner. The Operations Worker supports the day-to-day operation and maintenance of all city infrastructure.

Key Responsibilities

Reporting to the Civic Works Assistant Managers, the Operations Worker is responsible for operating light equipment, including loader, trackless, skid steer, and trucks, with or without sander or snowplow attachments. They also perform labour in completion of a variety of duties including road maintenance and repairs, paving, excavations, snow and ice control, street sweeping, park maintenance, mowing, brushing and hauling.

Qualifications

The successful candidates will have a BC Drivers licence Class 5 with Air Brake Endorsement or equivalent, Sound knowledge of techniques, tools, equipment and safety procedures of a civic works department and skills in the operation and care of vehicles, equipment and tools. Grade 12 or GED is an Essential Qualification and working knowledge of computers and Microsoft Office programs is required.
